We aim to make sure that the personal information we collect, use or disclose is accurate, complete and up-to-date. We will take reasonable steps to make sure this is the case. This way we can provide you with better service.

If you believe your personal information is not accurate, complete or up-to- date, please contact us.

Protecting your personal information

We store information in different ways, including in paper and electronic form. The security of your personal information is important to us and we take reasonable steps to protect it from misuse and loss and unauthorised access, modification, or disclosure.

Some of the ways we do this are:

- a. confidentiality requirements for our employees.
- b. document storage security policies
- c. security measures for systems access.
- d. providing a discreet environment for confidential discussions.
- e. only allowing access to personal information where the individual seeking access has satisfied our identification requirements.
- f. access control for our buildings.
- g. the security measures described below under 'Our Website'.

Your privacy on the Internet

Our website:

We undertake to ensure that the personal information you give us on our website is protected.

For example, our websites have electronic security systems in place, including the use of firewalls and data encryption. User identifiers, passwords or other access codes may also be used to control access to your personal information.

Please refer to the website of those Group organisations with which you transact electronically for more information on our website specific privacy and security procedures.

Links to other sites:

You may be able to access external websites by clicking on links we have provided. Those other websites are not subject to our privacy standards, policies, and procedures. You will need to contact or review those websites directly to ascertain their privacy standards, policies, and procedures.

Gaining access to your personal information

You can gain access to your personal information. This is subject to some exceptions allowed by law.

Factors affecting a right to access include:

- a. Access would pose a serious threat to the life or health of any individual.
- b. Access would have an unreasonable impact on the privacy of others
- c. A frivolous or vexatious request
- d. The information relates to a commercially sensitive decision making process
- e. Access would be unlawful
- Access would prejudice enforcement activities relating to criminal activities and other breaches of law, public revenue, a security function or negotiations with you, or legal dispute resolution proceedings
- g. Denying access is required or authorised by or under law.
 We will give you reasons if we deny access.

Contact us to obtain a form requesting access. In some cases, we may be able to deal with your request over the telephone or online.

Using government identifiers

If in certain circumstances we are required to collect government identifiers such as your Tax File Number, we do not use or disclose this information other than where required and authorised by law.

Dealing with us anonymously

You can deal with us anonymously where it is lawful and practicable to do so. For example, if you enquire about product, you do not need to provide your personal details.

Your sensitive information

Without your consent, we will not collect information about you that reveals your racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs or affiliations, membership of a professional or trade association, membership of a trade union, details of health, disability, sexual orientation, or criminal record.

This is subject to some exceptions including:

- a. The collection is required by law
- b. When the information is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defence of a legal claim
- c. Resolving your privacy issues

If you have any issues you wish to raise with OPSEC or would like to discuss any issues about our Privacy Policy, then you are able to do so in a number of ways.

You are always welcome to speak directly to our Agents and they will do their best to resolve your issue. If investigation is required, we will keep you advised of progress.
